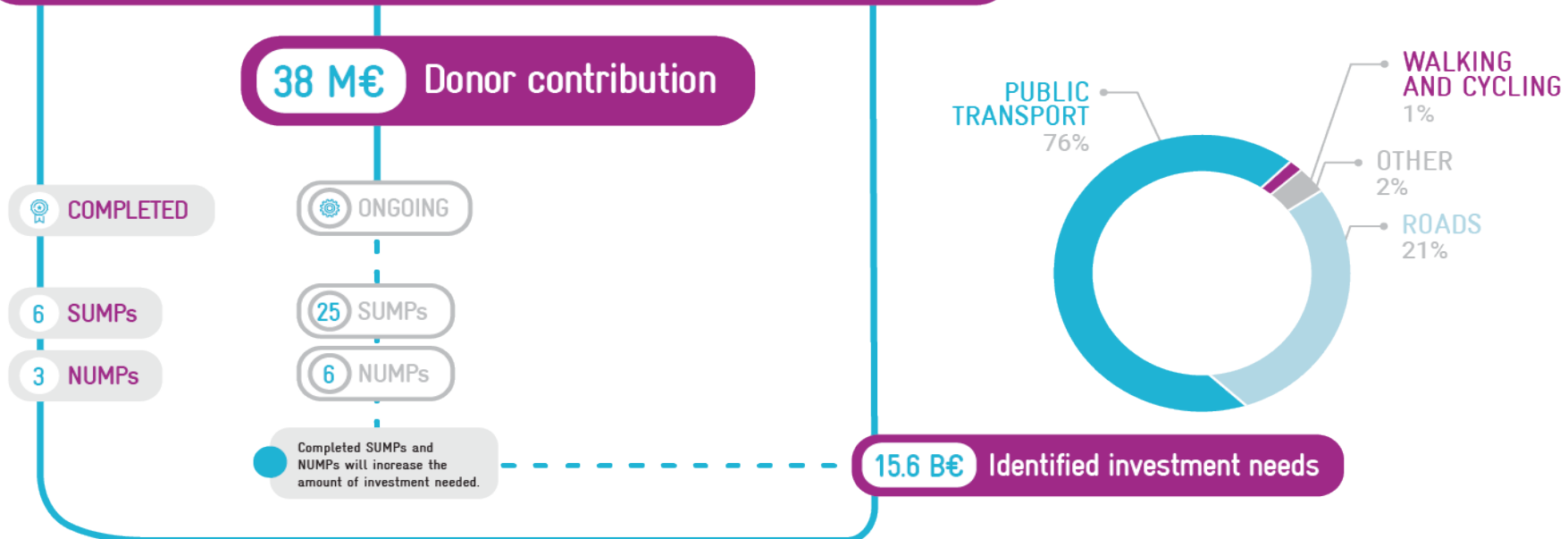

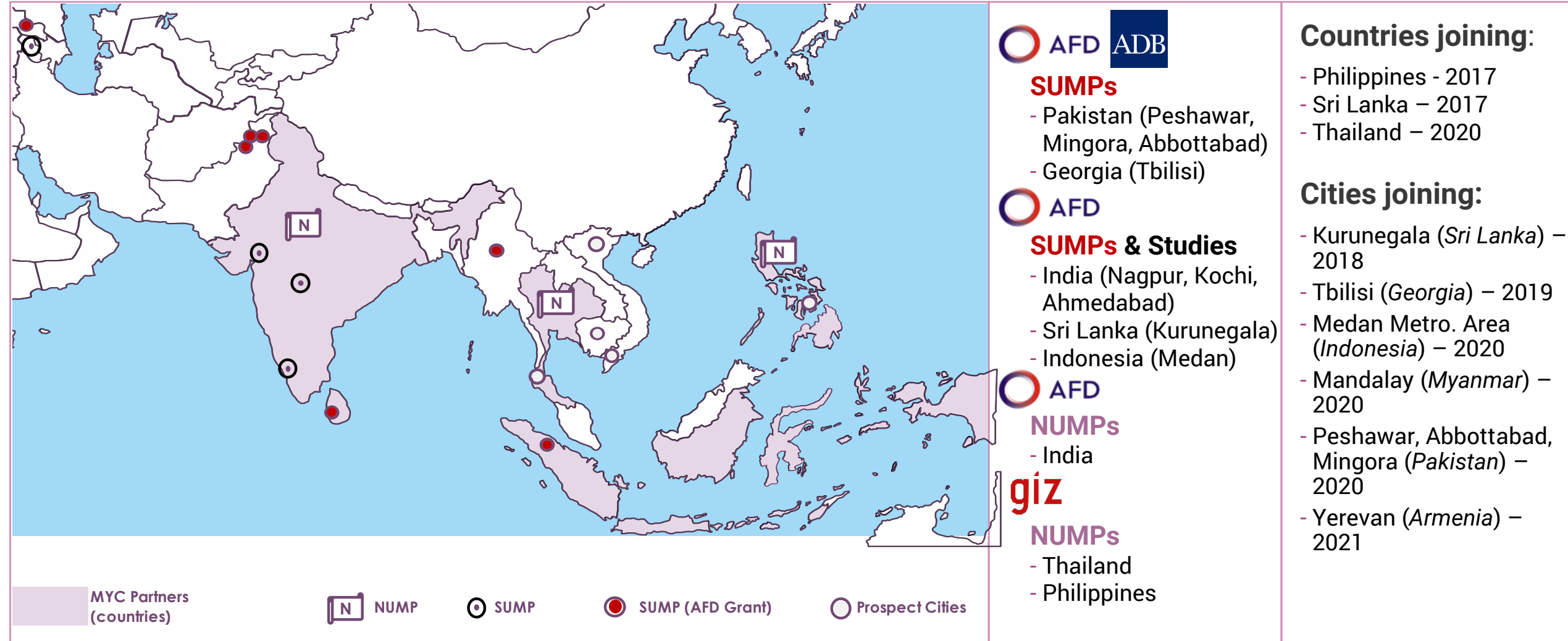

MobiliseYourCity Strategy for Paratransit



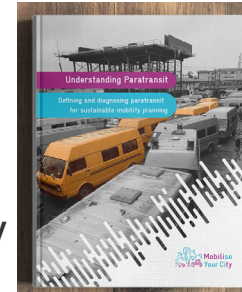
- ❖ **Recognising the paratransit services as complementary transport** services to the official and so-called formal public transport. Paratransit sector is a complement, not a substitute.
- ❖ **Supporting the modernisation** of the paratransit sector towards a better structured service making use of digital technologies, and with low-carbon solutions to limit the sector's negative externalities.
- ❖ **Ensuring the integration** of the paratransit sector in the SUMP elaboration, both from a technical and social perspective.
