Governance

- Local municipality in charge of public transport regulation

- Police gets low wages

Current supply

- Minibuses are provided for most of the daily trips
- Moto-taxis are becoming more and more important
- No MRT, previous bus company which collapsed in the 1980's

Demand

- Multi-million city with fast growth over the past decades
- Demand is growing, mostly from peripheral areas where a lot of the rural population is migrating, leading to a rapid sprawl of the urban area towards the smaller neighbouring towns

Planning

- SUMP to be implemented
- BRT project to be implemented by the transport department at the municipality




